*Hydrangea anomala petiolaris*

**Climbing Hydrangea**

\$30.99 (3 gal.), \$52.99 (7 gal.)

40'+ht

Part shade to Full shade

Vigorous, sprawling, deciduous vine with heart-shaped lustrous dark green leaves and large white clusters of June flowers. Mature plants have an attractive exfoliating, reddish brown bark giving it some winter interest. Also it makes an ideal ground cover in shady areas or steep embankments.

*Hydrangea arborescens*

**'Annabelle'**

\$35.99 (5 gal.)

4/5'ht x 4/5'w

Full sun to Part shade

Very cold hardy hydrangea with massive flower heads held upright on sturdy stems. Large flowers open green, then mature to white before fading to green again. Blooming in midsummer on new growth makes it a very reliable variety.

*Hydrangea macrophylla*

**'All Summer Beauty'**

\$48.99 (7 gal.)

4/5'ht x 4/5'w

Part sun to Part shade

Prolific flowering mophead hydrangea with lustrous dark green foliage and bearing pink/lavender blooms in neutral soil and vivid blue in acidic soil. Very dependable old variety blooming on new and old wood. Good for cut flower arrangements.

**'Alpenluhen' Glowing Embers**

\$27.99

4/5' ht x 4/5' w

Part sun to Part shade

Classic rosy-red mophead hydrangea, even in slightly acidic soil. Considered one of the hardiest red mopheads. The dark green glossy foliage allowing it to withstand more sun than some of the other varieties.

**'Ami Pasquier'**

\$27.99

3/4'ht x 3/4'w

Part sun to Part shade

Showy medium-sized mophead hydrangea with crimson wine colored blooms that contrasts nicely with its glossy green leaves which turn red in the fall. A strong plant that has been assessed over many years and possess the remontant trait.

**'Domotoi'**

\$48.99 (7 gal.)

4/5' ht x 4/5' w

Part sun to Part shade

Japanese variety with large double florets with serrated sepals. The flower are pastel tones of pink in neutral soil turning mauve to blue in acidic soil. Quite unusual with its irregular blooms and attractive glossy dark foliage.

**'Dooley'**

\$27.99

5/6' ht x 4/5' w

Part sun to Part shade

Robust mophead hydrangea that has proven to be extremely cold-hardy and is a little larger than other blue mopheads. Produces very large blue or pink mophead flowers with medium green foliage and considered to be a re-bloomer. Good for cut flower arrangements.

**‘Endless Summer’** \$38.99 (5 gal.)  
4/5’ ht x 4/5’ w Part sun to Part shade  
Reliable cold-hardy classic blue mophead hydrangea blooming on new and old wood.

**‘Enziandom’** \$29.99  
3/4’ ht x 4/5’ w Part sun to Part shade  
Prized for the large deep blue mophead flowers and dense habit. The large mopheads are supported by stout stems filled dark green foliage. Great variety for drying with the blooms fading to a lovely blue/green color. Very suitable for a container planting.

**‘ES14’ Let’s Dance® Rhapsody Blue™** \$29.99  
2/3’ ht x 2/3’ w Part sun to Part shade  
Recent introduction mophead hydrangea with rich blue flowers, a tight shape and sturdy stems. Blooms on new and old wood. This variety’s flowers can easily be shifted from rich amethyst blue to pink.

**‘Lanarth White’** \$27.99  
4/5’ ht x 4/5’ w Part sun to Part shade  
Clear pure white lacecap hydrangea with pink to blue fertile flowers in the center of bloom. The tapered, thick-textured dark green leaves add to the contrasting colors of this plant. Flowers dry well for arrangements.

**‘Princess Juliana’** \$27.99  
4/5’ ht x 4/5’ w Part sun to Part shade  
Classic white mophead hydrangea which blooms later than most *Hydrangea macrophylla* and tends to be a bit slower growing. Produces creamy white flowers that turn blush with age. Foliage isn’t as susceptible to sun scorch and mildew as other white mopheads.

*Hydrangea paniculata*

**‘Greenspire’** \$29.99  
7/8’ ht x 5/6’ w Full sun to Part shade  
Panicle hydrangea with a strong upright form that produces 12-inch long inflorescences with a mixture of lime green fertile florets and showy white flowers aging to pink. One of best recent panicle hydrangea introductions. Good for cut flower arrangements.

**‘Jane’ Little Lime™** \$29.99 , \$35.99 (5 gal.), \$48.99 (7 gal.)  
4/5’ht x 3/4’w Full sun to Part shade  
Dwarf form of the ever popular ‘Limelight’ sporting the same dense upright form with great chartreuse-lime panicles. Panicles turn creamy white and eventually acquiring a pink to rose tone. Excellent flowers for fresh arrangements or drying.

**‘Limelight’** \$29.99 , \$35.99 (5 gal.)  
6/7’ht x 4/5’w Full sun to Part shade  
Dense upright form with great chartreuse-lime panicles. Panicles turn creamy white and eventually acquiring a pink to rose tone. Excellent flowers for fresh arrangements or drying.

*Hydrangea quercifolia*

**‘Munchkin’** \$50.99 (7 gal.)  
3/3.5’ht x 3/4’w Full sun to Part shade  
Compact oakleaf hydrangea with upright flowers in early summer that open white and age to a medium pink. Dark green, deeply lobed leaves turn a brilliant mahogany in autumn. Suited for the small residential landscape.

Hydrangea serrata

**'Blue Deckle'** \$29.99

3/4' ht x 3/4' w                      Part sun to Part shade  
Compact lacecap hydrangea with a loose form and frilly serrated flowers. Pale pink or blue flowers open up in July. Like other serratas, the leaves will turn orange and red in the fall. Very hardy and blooms on new growth.

**'MAKD' Tiny Tuff Stuff™**

1.5/2' ht x 1.5/2'w                      Full sun to Part shade \$29.99  
New dwarf lacecap hydrangea which is extremely bud-hardy which produces an abundant number of flowers. It is a rebloomer. The flowers are pale pink or blue and aged to an attractive pink tone in fall.

**'Painter's Palette'**

4/5'ht x 4/5'w                      Full sun to Part sun \$29.99  
A new introduction with compact form and dark green foliage. When in bloom it provides some of the most uniquely colored blooms, white with green and blue tinges eventually turning pink.

Other flowering shrubs and vines

Buddleia davidii

**'Nanho Blue'** \$29.99 (7 gal.)

4/5'ht x 3/4'w                      Full sun  
Butterfly bush which has mauve-blue flowers, willowy gray-green foliage, and an arching, spreading habit. It's fragrant flowers bloom from June to September. It needs to be cut back in late winter to maintain a nice form. Ideal for a sunny location in mixed garden border and is drought tolerant once established.

Clethra alnifolia

3/4'ht x 3/4'w                      Full sun to Shade \$21.99, \$27.99 (5 gal.)  
Slow spreading native deciduous shrub which has fluffy, bottle bush-like spikes of extremely fragrant white flowers. It blooms in mid to late summer and flowers last for around four weeks. Glossy dark green leaves that turn a splendid yellow color in autumn.

Hibiscus syriacus

**'Diana'** \$59.99 (10 gal.)

8/10'ht x 6/8'w                      Full sun to Part sun  
Deciduous shrub featuring dark green leaves with a dense, compact growth habit. Large pure white flowers will bloom abundantly and nearly continuously from midsummer until frost. Makes a wonderful informal hedge or screen. It will tolerate heat, drought, and poor soil once established.

Lagerstroemia x

**'Muskogee'** \$39.99 (7 gal.)

6/8'ht x 5/6'w                      Full sun to Part sun  
Deciduous, upright multi-stemmed shrub with long panicles of light lavender-pink flowers from mid-summer through early fall. This crape myrtle variety is one of several mildew resistant hybrids. It features dark green foliage which turns orange-red in the fall and a dark cinnamon brown exfoliating bark.

*Viburnum plicatum tomentosum*

**'Summer Snowflake'**

\$62.99 (10 gal.)

6/8'ht x 6/8'w

Full sun to part shade

Broadly upright deciduous shrub with tiered horizontal branches displaying the large flat white flower clusters. Flowers in spring and continues to bloom sporadically throughout summer. Red fruit in fall is very ornamental.

*Vitex agnus-castus*

**Chastetree**

\$59.99 (10 gal.)

6/7'ht x 5/6'w

Full sun

A superb medium-sized deciduous shrub with aromatic palmate leaves. Tiny, fragrant lilac flowers appear in 12"-18" loose panicles throughout the summer into early fall. Leaves are grayish-green and quite fragrant when bruised. Flowers are quite attractive to butterflies and bees. Late to break bud in the spring.
